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Effective January 14, 2013, propoxyphene will be removed from the following drug testing panels and replaced with buprenorphine:

- 1. Pain Clinic Survey with Confirmation
 - a. Lab Test Code: PCS10
 - b. Clinic: Pain Clinic Survey w/ Confirm
 - c. Centricity: Pain Clinic Survey w/ Confirm, Urine
 - d. Downtime: Write-In (Form II)
- 2. Pain Clinic Survey Without Confirmation
 - a. Lab Test Code: PCS10WO
 - b. Clinic: Pain Clinic Survey w/o Confirm
 - c. Centricity: Pain Clinic Survey w/o Confirm
 - d. Downtime: Write-In (Form II)
- 3. Drug of Abuse Survey with Confirmation, Urine
 - a. Lab Test Code: DAS
 - b. Clinic: DAU Survey with Confirmation
 - c. Centricity: Drug of Abuse Survey
 - d. Downtime: Write-In (Form II)
- 4. Drug Screen, Comprehensive, Urine
 - a. Lab Test Code: TOXI
 - b. Clinic: Drug Scn, Comprehensive-Ur
 - c. Centricity: Drug Scn, Comprehensive-Ur
 - d. Downtime: Write-In (Form II)



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Laboratory News

Propoxyphene (Darvon) was taken off the market in November 2010 due to its numerous possible side-effects. As a result, the Toxicology Lab very rarely sees patients with propoxyphene present. Propoxyphene may still be ordered as a single test if so desired.

Buprenorphine (Suboxone) is a highly prescribed and abused semi-synthetic opioid. To best suit drugtesting needs, this test will replace propoxyphene in the above panels.
