Effective June 21st, 2021, Anti-cardiolipin and Beta 2 Glycoprotein testing will change from ELISA methodology to chemiluminescent methodology. These changes will impact the tests used to evaluate antiphospholipid syndrome as shown below.

 A new panel test, Antiphospholipid Antibodies (Test code APLSAB) will be created and will include the following components:

Beta 2 Glycoprotein IgA, IgG, and IgM

Cardiolipin Antibody IgA, IgG and IgM

Test Code: APLSAB

CPT Code: 86146x3, 86147x3

Specimen: Serum; collect in RTT or STT

2. The Comprehensive Antiphospholipid Syndrome panel (Test code CAPS) will have the ACL and B2G screen tests replaced with the Antiphospholipid Antibodies test. The components will include:
